**Inspired by Van Gogh and the contemporary artist, Wolf Kahn, New York artist Linda Roscetti fills her canvases with rich earth tones and interpretive, vibrant colors. Her fluid brush strokes are often enhanced with the deliberate accents and added texture of a palette knife. She paints from on-site studies, reference photographs, and ideas held in her imagination, illustrating a genuine intimacy with her local surroundings.**

**Linda's ongoing portfolio entitled *Mondi Comuni (Shared Worlds)*, includes a variety of neo-realistic and abstract works inspired by her passion for both the Finger Lakes Region and the captivating hills of Tuscany. She is enchanted by their mutually engaging farmland, vineyards, barns, architecture, and rolling terrains.**

**Linda graduated from Ithaca College in 1973 and in 2000 began complimenting her career in physical therapy with her ongoing life's pursuit of painting. She studied art at the Sam Russo Studio in Niagara Falls, NY, the Parson's School of Design, and the Art Students League of NY. Her work is currently shown in decorator showrooms in Litchfield, CT, Locust Valley, NY, and Palm Beach, FL.**

**Environmentally aware and concerned, Linda has donated works to many "green" charities, including Litchfield's Housatonic Conservancy, Hudson Valley Esopus Creek Conservancy, and Eco Art Gallery by the Sea in Miami Beach.**

**Linda works in her studio in upstate New York and paints regularly in Pari, a medieval hilltown in Tuscany, 20 miles south of Siena. She has been actively painting in Ithaca and Trumansburg for the past three summers.**
